Many thanks for your query regarding the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), Section 6(h).

On 6 January 2021, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the equivalent of the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA), passed the final terms of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) Section 6(h).

This enacted rules to reduce exposure to the following PBT chemicals and came into force in March 2021.

- PIP (3:1) Phenol, Isopropylated Phosphate (3:1) (CAS no.: 68937-41-7)
- DecaBDE Decabromodiphenyl ether (CAS no.: 1163-19-5)
- TTBP 2,4,6-Tris (tert-butyl)phenol (CAS no.: 732-26-3)
- HCBD Hexachlorobutadiene (CAS no.: 87-68-3)
- PCTP Pentachlorothiophenol (CAS no.: 133-49-3)
